IL MONDIALE SUPERSPORT 2023 RIPARTE DA ASSEN

Dopo una lunga pausa, il Mondiale SuperSport è pronto per tornare in azione. Nel prossimo weekend si corre ad Assen sullo storico TT Circuit, quello che viene definito come “la università delle due ruote” anche se dopo le modifiche del 2006 non è più lo stesso. Si tratta del primo round in Europa del calendario SBK 2023.

La pista misura 4,542 chilometri ed è costituito da 18 curve, 12 a destra e 6 a sinistra. Il rettilineo più lungo è di 487 metri. In Olanda non è la velocità massima a fare la differenza, però un buon motore aiuta sempre. Certamente è importante avere una moto efficace in curva e con ottimo spunto in accelerazione. È un tracciato stretto e tortuoso, ci sono curve veloci e rapidi cambi di direzione.

Andrea e il Team Evan Bros sono pronti per riscattarsi e portare a casa quei punti che sono mancati in Australia e Indonesia.

Andrea Mantovani: Sarà sicuramente un week end positivo, cercheremo di crescere turno dopo turno, provando il setup ideale e prendendo confidenza con la Yamaha R6. THE 2023 WORLD SUPERSPORT CHAMPIONSHIP STARTS AGAIN FROM ASSEN

After a long break, the SuperSport World Championship is ready to get back into action. Next weekend we'll be racing in Assen on the historic TT Circuit, what is defined as "the university of two wheels" even if after the changes in 2006 it is no longer the same. This is the first round in Europe of the 2023 SBK calendar.

The track measures 4.542 kilometers and consists of 18 corners, 12 to the right and 6 to the left. The longest straight is 487 metres. In Holland it's not the top speed that makes the difference, but a good engine always helps. It is certainly important to have a bike that is effective in cornering and with excellent acceleration. It's a narrow and winding track, there are fast corners and quick changes of direction.

Andrea and the Evan Bros Team are ready to redeem themselves and bring home the points they missed in Australia and Indonesia.

Andrea Mantovani: It will certainly be a positive weekend, we will try to improve session after session, trying out the ideal setup and getting familiar with the Yamaha R6. I'm very energized and convinced that the results won't be long in coming, I don't set myself any expectations but I just have the great desire to grow and create something important with Evan Bros. I also pay particular attention to the weather conditions where they are often unpredictable and determined on this track for the result. I thank the sponsors and all the people who are believing in me and in my potential.
